LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 2011

LOCAL LAW OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN
SUBDIVISION 5 OF GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW OF 3-C TO OVERRIDE
THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR THE TOWN OF SHELDON FIRE DISTRICT

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Sheldon as follows:

SECTION 1:

The tax levy limit for the Town of Sheldon Fire District shall be One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars for the year 2012.

SECTION 2:

This Local Law shall be submitted for approval to the Sheldon Town Board at the next general Town Board Meeting and Public Hearing on October 18, 2011.

SECTION 3:

Any other Local Law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State after approval by 60% percent of the members of the Sheldon Town Board in accordance with the requirements of Section 3-C of Subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law.

A Resolution to override the tax levy limit established in Subdivision 5 of
General Municipal Law Section 3-C

Resolution of October 18, 2011

Town of Sheldon, County of Wyoming on behalf of Special Improvement
District Sheldon Fire District

WHEREAS, The Town of Sheldon has contractual authority to vote on all legislative matters involving the Town of Sheldon Fire District, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Town of Sheldon Fire District to override the tax levy limit in order to increase Fire District Facilities, and

WHEREAS, this resolution is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law Section 3-C, which expressly authorizes the Sheldon Town Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a resolution approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the town board;

Now Therefore be it,

Resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Sheldon, County of Wyoming is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2012 on behalf of the Sheldon Fire District that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise proscribed in General Municipal Law, Section 3-C.
