**A LOCAL LAW OF THE TOWN OF SHELDON PROHIBITING REGISTERED SEX OFFENDERS FROM ESTABLISHING RESIDENCY AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS IN THE TOWN OF SHELDON AND FROM KNOWINGLY ENTERING INTO OR UPON ANY SCHOOL GROUNDS OR OTHER LOCATION AS SPECIFIED.**

**SECTION 1 - TITLE:**

This Local Law shall be known and cited as "A Local Law of the Town of Sheldon Prohibiting registered sex offenders from establishing residency at certain locations in the Town of Sheldon and from knowingly entering into or upon any school grounds or other location as specified.

**SECTION 2 - PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Local Law is to prohibit registered sex offenders from establishing residency in certain locations in the Town of Sheldon and from knowingly entering into or upon other specific locations in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of children of the Town of Sheldon.

**SECTION 3- PROHIBITED CONDUCT:**

A registered sex offender as defined under the New York State Correction Law, Executive Law, and/or Penal Law is hereby prohibited from establishing a residence or knowingly entering in or upon any school ground as defined under the New York State Penal Law Section 220.00 (14) and any other location where children regularly congregate such as parks, or special events, playgrounds, amusement parks or a carnival location or within one thousand (1,000) feet of the same.

**SECTION 4 - VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES:**

A Violation of this Local Law will constitute a Class A Misdemeanor Crime as defined under the Penal Law of the state of New York.

**SECTION 5 - SEPARABILITY:**

Should any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Local Law be declared unconstitutional or unjust for any reason by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction, the remainder of this Local Law shall not be affected thereby.

**SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as set forth under the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.
