

LOCAL LAW NO.: 3 OF 2010

LOCAL LAW PROVIDING A FOUR-YEAR TERM FOR THE ELECTIVE OFFICE OF THE TOWN SUPERVISOR OF THE TOWN OF SHELDON

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Sheldon as follows:

Section 1.

The term of office of elective Town Supervisor of the Town of Sheldon shall be four years. Such four-year term shall commence on the first day of January following the first biennial Town election after the effective date of this Local Law.

Section 2.

At the biennial town election next following the effective date of this Local Law, and every four years thereafter, the Town Supervisor shall be elected for a term of four years.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Sheldon section 24 of the Town Law of New York State with respect to the term of office of the elective Town Supervisor.

Section 4.

This Local Law shall be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Sheldon at the next general town election to be held on November 2, 2010.

Section 5. Any other Local Law, ordinance or resolution inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 6.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
