
A Shared Favorite Recipe: (courtesy of Joann Pilc) "Zucchini Casserole" enjoy!

- 1 stick melted butter
- 2 cups grated carrots
- 3 small zucchini's (sliced & cooked until transparent)
- 1 16oz container of sour cream
- 1 8oz pkg Pepperidge Farm Stuffing Mix (crumbs)
- 1 can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 onion (chopped) as much as you prefer, sauté
- Grease 9x13 in. pan

Sauté vegetables in butter/margarine until zucchini is transparent. Add remaining ingredients, mixing well. Bake in a 9x13 covered pan at 350 degrees for 30-40 minutes.


